# TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2024-2025

Associate of Arts in Pre-Elementary Education at UC Clermont College to Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education at Northern Kentucky University

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Arts (AA) in Pre-Elementary Education degree at UC Clermont College and leads to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Elementary Education degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

# Degree Requirements for UC Clermont

To earn a degree at UC Clermont, a student must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, and earn a minimum of 15 credit hours at the institution awarding the degree.

# Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

Students wishing to enroll in the elementary education program must follow the admission guidelines for teacher education programs outlined by the College of Education. (Courses in parentheses are UC Clermont course equivalents.)

- A minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COMM 1071) and ENG 102 (ENGL 2089)
- A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses which include EDU 300 (ECE 2000), EDU 305 (EDST 1001), EDU 313 (CI 1001), and EDS 360 (SPED 1001).

- Meet the entrance exam requirement through an approved combination of passing scores on the ACT and/or Praxis I Core Academic Skills for Educators exams
  - o ACT Comp. 22 -OR-
  - o Reading (ACT: 20 -or- Praxis I: 156) and
  - o Eng./Writing (ACT: 18 -or- Praxis I: 162) and
  - o Mathematics (ACT: 19 -or- Praxis I: 150)

ACT scores must be less than 5 years old at time of admissions semester

- Pass criminal background check
- 60 semester hours completed
- An acceptable portfolio
- A completed application to the Teacher Education program

#### Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students majoring in Elementary Education must maintain a GPA of 2.75 overall and in major courses and earn a minimum grade of C in all education courses. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. No minor is required for this major.

EDU 307 is waived if student provides documentation of 50 hours of field experience in an education setting. If EDU 307 is waived, student must complete EDU 334: Portfolio Development (1 credit).

Students pursuing an elementary education major may also choose to concurrently complete a second major in special education. *EDS 360 Students with Exceptionalities in Schools* is not required for special education majors, so SPED 1001 can be replaced with another course at UC Clermont. For courses leading to certification in special education, refer to the Bachelor of Arts with a major in special education program description in the NKU Course Catalog.

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
